

## APPLICATION FOR COMMISSION ON IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS

**The Anne Arundel County Executive's Office is accepting applications for County residents to voluntarily serve on the Commission on Immigrant Affairs.**

The Commission will consist of 11 voting members appointed by the County Executive. The diverse group, according to Executive Order 15, shall consist of:

1. One immigrant residing in the County;
2. Two representatives of the business community who are immigrants and who reside in the County;
3. Two representatives of community-based organizations serving immigrant populations in the County who reside in the County;
4. Two representatives of faith-based organizations who are immigrants and who reside in the County;
5. Two attorneys with experience in immigration law;
6. One representative of the Annapolis City Council; and
7. One City of Annapolis resident representing a community-based organization that primarily serves immigrants and resides in the City.

The members of the Commission are responsible for acting as an advisory body that serves as a means for immigrant voices to be heard and understood, facilitates civic engagement among immigrants, and recognizes and legitimizes issues of importance to immigrants arriving in Anne Arundel County.
