Based on the Boat Launch Feasibility Study, January 2017 prepared by Bayland Consultants and Designers, Inc. <http://www.aacounty.org/AACoOIT/water-merged.pdf>. and consideration of public comment on the Study <http://www.aacounty.org/boards-and-commissions/water-access-commission/boat-ramp-location-study/boat-ramp-locations-study-public-comments.pdf> ; The AAWAC recommends the following:

1. Expand the search for potential ramp locations to include:
 - Partnerships or acquisition of existing commercial or community ramps
 - Sites such as David Taylor, Jonas Green and Arlington Echo, Brewer Pond and others on the Severn River
2. Conduct a thorough evaluation of Quiet Waters Park as the next County ramp project. Expand the evaluation to include creation of an Annapolis Boating Center to provide facilities for Chesapeake Region Accessible Boating (CRAB) and the Anne Arundel Paddling & Rowing Community (PARC) and other potential partners. See attached concept description.
3. FY 19 funding for design & construction at Beverly-Triton Beach Park
4. FY 19 funding for design/construction of next ramp and construction of Solley Cove ramp.
