## COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S MESSAGE

It's thrilling to see that over a third of our residents over 16 are vaccinated, to finally see our county dose allocations increasing, to finally have a state commitment for a mass vaccination site at Navy Stadium, and to project that by the end of April we'll likely have two-thirds of our residents vaccinated.

It's also exciting to see state and federal funds flowing to our hardest-hit families, new businesses opening, and the building blocks being put in place at every level of government to rebuild our economy from its foundation, the front-line workers who do the hardest work.

The only thing that can hold us back now is ourselves. Case rates are rising, and a fourth surge is possible when and where people refuse to wear masks and ignore distancing guidelines. Vaccines don't work when people don't step up and schedule appointments. You must do your part. Please, go to [aaccounty.org/covidvax](http://aaccounty.org/covidvax), or any of the sites on the back of this report, and register for your vaccine. Show up for your appointment. You'll be protecting yourself, protecting your loved ones, and directly assisting this community to put this pandemic behind us. Help a family member or a neighbor to register and get vaccinated as well. Some of us need the encouragement and support of people we trust to confront what we fear.

Thank you to everyone who is making this extraordinary achievement possible. Spring is here and progress is underway.

- 38,671 total confirmed cases and 562\* deaths
- 153,477 residents with first dose of vaccine
- 86,542 resident fully vaccinated
- 21.5 cases per 100,000 (7-day moving average)
- 1.12 infection rate
- 6.63% positive test rate
- 51 COVID patients hospitalized (AAMC & BWMC)

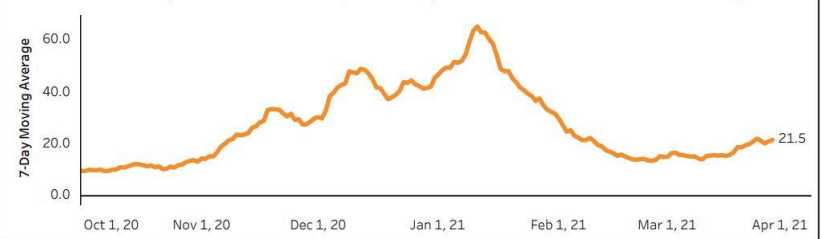

New Cases per 100,000 per Day, Anne Arundel County

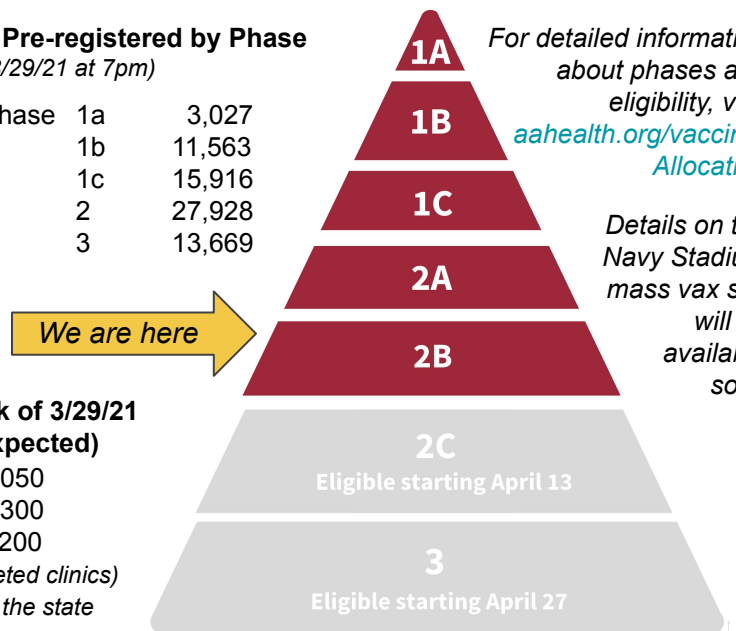
