COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S MESSAGE

As we enter week 17 of the vaccine effort, we are turning a corner. Over 30% of residents have received their first dose and 18% are fully vaccinated. With vaccine supply rapidly increasing, the supply will soon outstrip demand.

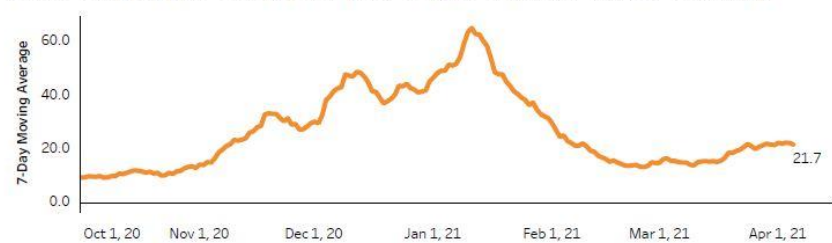
As we prepare for this shift, Anne Arundel County is removing some steps in the process. The pre-registration system that we created at the outset of the effort served its purpose. Our county was a leader in getting the most vulnerable residents prioritized, but we no longer need that extra registration step. Vaccines are available at many locations, and we want the process to be quick and user-friendly.

Starting today at 7 pm, AACounty.org/covidvax will offer direct links for appointments at the location of your choosing. You pick the site and the time, sign up, and show up. The mass vaccination site at Navy Stadium will open the week of April 12, and our community sites will be operating as well. We're also reaching out through churches, community centers, and residential facilities.

We're in a race against the virus and its variants to reach herd immunity through vaccination. The modeling suggests that we are winning, but victory depends on two things. One is that you continue to mask and distance. The other is that you get vaccinated, and work hard to help everyone you know find the time, the transportation, and the trust to get vaccinated as well. We can, and will, get this done. Thank you for doing your part.

Pre-registration is no longer required to sign up through the AACo Department of Health. You can schedule a vaccination appointment at aaccounty.org/covidvax Times and locations are posted Tuesdays at 7pm and Thursdays at 12pm

- 73 COVID patients hospitalized (AAMC & BWMC)

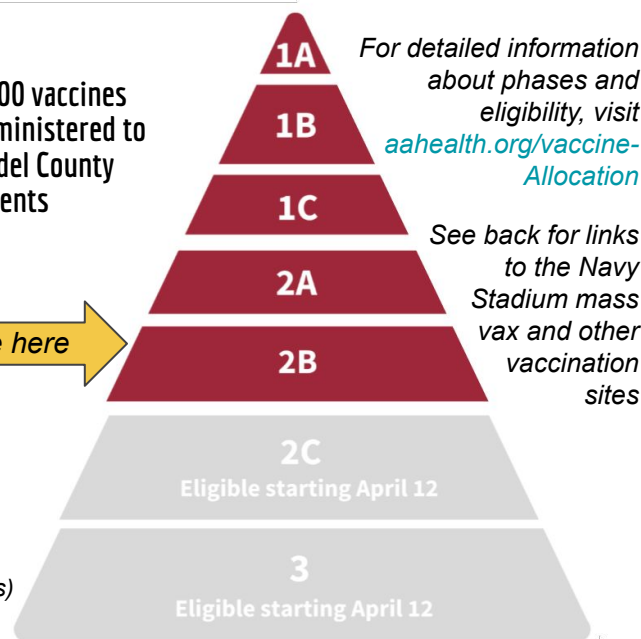
