COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S MESSAGE

Today, I announced that indoor and outdoor social gathering restrictions will be lifted. We are making progress, but we're not there yet. Warm weather makes a difference, which is great news for everyone participating in summer activities. But, getting vaccinated is the only way we can stay on track and reduce the spread of COVID-19 and its variants once temperatures decrease again this fall.

We have made it convenient for anyone who wants a vaccine to get one. You can go to a mass vaccination site, a local pharmacy, or one of many Department of Health's local community clinics. Sign up at aaccounty.org/covidvax.

Last week, I asked you to share this update and vaccination information with anyone who needed it, and I am requesting your help again. As of yesterday, only 30% of our vaccination appointments were filled. Please encourage your family and friends to get vaccinated. This is our chance to end the pandemic and everyone has the opportunity to help us cross the finish line.

UPDATED HEALTH METRICS


As of 4/27/21:

- 42,219 total confirmed cases and 590* deaths
- 236,601 residents with first dose of vaccine
- 173,772 resident fully vaccinated
- 18.6 cases per 100,000 (7-day moving average)
- 0.96 infection rate
- 6.58% positive test rate
- 69 COVID patients hospitalized (AAMC & BWMC)

*includes 14 not tested

OVER **408,800** vaccines have been administered to Anne Arundel County residents.
