108.2.1.3 Churches and other nonprofit agencies. Churches, parsonages, eleemosynary, and community association facilities, and fire stations on properties owned by a volunteer fire company formed pursuant to § 12-1-201 of this Code shall be charged the minimum fee under 108.2.1, 108.2.3, 108.2.4, 108.2.5, and 108.2.6.

9 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from
10 the date it becomes law.


