1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Board of Appeals – Compensation

3 FOR the purpose of making a per diem allowance for members of the Board of Appeals  
4 subject to the approval of the ~~Administrative Officer to the County Council Chairman and~~  
5 Vice Chairman of the Board of Appeals rather than the Controller; and generally relating  
6 to compensation for the members of the Board of Appeals.

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
12 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

1 (a) **Generally.** Each member of the Board of Appeals is entitled to an annual salary of  
2 \$5,250.



4 (b) **Per diem allowance.** In addition to the salary provided in subsection (a), each  
5 member is entitled to a per diem allowance of \$75 for each day on which the member incurs  
6 necessary travel and incidental expenses while engaged in the discharge of official duties. The  
7 allowance is subject to the approval of the [Controller] ~~ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO THE~~  
8 ~~COUNTY COUNCIL CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF APPEALS ON A FORM~~  
9 ~~PREPARED BY THE CLERK TO THE BOARD OF APPEALS.~~

11 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from  
12 the date it becomes law.


