A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Transfer of Funds
2 – Chief Administrative Officer – Contingency – Department of Public Works

3
4 FOR the purpose of transferring an appropriation of funds from the Chief Administrative
5 Office Contingency Account to the Department of Public Works for snow removal; and
6 making this Ordinance an emergency measure.

8 BY amending: Current Expense Budget

9
10 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the
11 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,
12 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County
13 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and

14
15 WHEREAS, under § 712 of the Charter, upon recommendation of the County
16 Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations from
17 contingent funds, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such
18 funds are available for such appropriation; and

20 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended that funds from the FY2015
21 appropriation to the Chief Administrative Office, Contingency, be transferred to the
22 Department of Public Works; and

24 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for
25 appropriation; now, therefore,

1 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
2 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, be and it is hereby
3 amended by transferring from the below-listed department in the amount set forth:

5 Chief Administrative Office – General Fund Appropriation
6 Contingency
7 Grants, Contributions & Other \$ 7,800,000

9 to the below-listed department in the amount set forth:

11 Department of Public Works – General Fund Appropriation
12 Bureau of Highways
13 Personal Services \$ 1,700,000
14 Contractual Services \$ 3,100,000
15 Supplies & Materials \$ 3,000,000

17 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
18 emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
19 health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of five
20 members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.


