A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning: Zoning – Dog Grooming and Day Care Facilities

1 FOR the purpose of adding dog grooming and day care facilities as a permitted use in  
2 Small Business Districts; and generally related to zoning.

4 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments: § 18-9-402  
5 (Anne Arundel County Code, 2005, as amended)

7 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
8 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

10 **ARTICLE 18. ZONING**

12 **TITLE 9. OTHER ZONING DISTRICTS**

13  
14 **18-9-402. Permitted, conditional, and special exception uses.**

15  
16 The permitted, conditional, and special exception uses allowed in the Small  
17 Business Districts are listed in the chart in this section using the following key: P =  
18 permitted use; C = conditional use; SE = special exception use. Except as provided  
19 otherwise in this article, uses and structures customarily accessory to the listed uses also  
20 are allowed. Outside storage as an accessory use is not allowed, except that the owner-  
21 occupant of a dwelling may store on the lot one commercial vehicle or a vehicle used for  
22 commercial purposes having a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of not more  
23 than 10,000 pounds.



SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days after it becomes law.






