A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Position Control in the Classified Service

3 FOR the purpose of obtaining approval to increase and decrease the number of positions in
4 certain classifications in the classified service; providing for the applicability of this
5 Ordinance; and generally relating to the classified service.

7 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
8 That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)
9 this Ordinance shall approve an increase of eighty-eight Fire Fighter II, six Fire Fighter III,
10 one Fire Fighter/Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic, fifteen Fire Lieutenants, and
11 three Fire Captain positions in the Fire Department from the number of positions approved in
12 these classifications as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance.

14 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne
15 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve a decrease of one
16 Construction Inspection Supervisor and six Construction Inspector positions in the
17 Department of Inspections and Permits approved in these classifications as part of the Annual
18 Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

20 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne
21 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve an increase of one
22 Environmental Control Inspection Supervisor and six Environmental Control Inspector
23 positions in the Department of Inspections and Permits approved in these classifications as
24 part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

1 SECTION 4. *And be it further enacted*, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne
2 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve a decrease of one
3 Project Development Administrator in the Office of Information Technology approved in this
4 classification as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

6 SECTION 5. *And be it further enacted*, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne
7 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve an increase of one
8 Information Technology Senior Project Manager in the Office of Information Technology
9 approved in this classification as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.
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11 SECTION 6. *And be it further enacted*, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne
12 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve a decrease of one
13 Automotive Service Worker in the Department of Public Works approved in this classification
14 as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.
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16 SECTION 7. *And be it further enacted*, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne
17 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve an increase of one
18 Automotive Mechanic II position in the Department of Public Works approved in this
19 classification as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.
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21 SECTION 8. *And be it further enacted*, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne
22 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve a decrease of two
23 Detention Officers in the Department of Detention Facilities approved in this classification as
24 part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.
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26 SECTION 9. *And be it further enacted*, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne
27 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve an increase of one
28 Detention Sergeant and one Detention Captain in the Department of Detention Facilities
29 approved in these classifications as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.
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31 SECTION 10. *And be it further enacted*, That changes to position control under Sections
32 1 through 9 of this Ordinance shall take effect at the beginning of the first full pay period on
33 or after the effective date of this Ordinance.
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35 SECTION 11. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
36 from the date it becomes law.


