A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Classified Service – Extra shift – Bonus payment
2
3 FOR the purpose of amending the method of bonus pay for certain employees; providing for
4 the application of this Ordinance; and generally relating to personnel.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 6-1-218
7 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)
8

9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
10 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

12 **ARTICLE 6. PERSONNEL**

13 **TITLE 1. CLASSIFIED SERVICE**

14 **6-1-218. Extra shift – Bonus payment.**
15

16 (a) **Memorandum of agreement applicability.** Bonus pay shall be paid to employees
17 in the classification of Fire Battalion Chief as provided by the applicable memorandum of
18 agreement negotiated and executed under Title 4.

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21 (b) **Non-represented employees.** At the discretion of the Fire Chief, a non-represented

1 uniformed fire officer may receive a bonus [of up to \$1,100] for an additional tour of duty
2 worked beyond the officer's regularly assigned shifts for the purpose of covering a field
3 operations vacancy; providing instruction to emergency personnel; providing repair
4 capability for emergency apparatus and facilities; and responding to emergencies as part of a
5 special tactical team. [Effective the first full pay period on or after January 1, 2014, at the
6 discretion of the Fire Chief, a non-represented uniformed fire officer may receive a bonus of
7 up to \$1,133 for an additional tour of duty worked beyond the officer's regularly assigned
8 shifts for the purpose of covering a field operations vacancy; providing instruction to
9 emergency personnel; providing repair capability for emergency apparatus and facilities; and
10 responding to emergencies as part of a special tactical team.] THE BONUS AMOUNT SHALL
11 FOLLOW THE SAME PAY SCHEDULE AS PERMITTED IN SUBSECTION (A).

13 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply
14 retroactively to the first full pay period beginning on or after January 1, 2015.



17 from the date it becomes law.


