3 FOR the purpose of removing a provision related to ownership of a commercial bingo
4 license; and generally relating to commercial bingo licenses.

6 By repealing and reenacting with amendments: §11-2-211(a)
7 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
10 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as

15 TITLE 2. AMUSEMENTS

17 **11-2-211. Ownership and control by commercial bingo licensees.**

18
19 (a) **Generally.** A commercial bingo licensee shall be the actual owner and operator of
20 the business conducting the commercial bingo games. This provision does not preclude a
21 licensee from renting the premises where the bingo games are located. [There may be no
22 cross-ownership of commercial bingo licenses and an individual, partnership,
23 corporation, or other business entity may not hold more than one commercial bingo
24 license. An individual may not be a director, officer, owner, or managerial employee



2 interest in more than one license.]


