A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Positions in the Exempt Service

3 FOR the purpose of adding the position of Transit Officer to the exempt service;
4 providing for the pay increase for two positions in the exempt service; providing for
5 the pay, pension, and financial disclosure requirements applicable to the position
6 added to the exempt service; providing for the applicability of this Ordinance; and
7 generally relating to personnel.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 6-2-101(a); and 6-2-103(a)

12 apply to the first full pay period beginning on or after July 1, 2016.


