A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Exempt Service – Deputy Planning and  
2 Zoning Officer

4 FOR the purpose of adding a certain position to the exempt service; providing for the pay,  
5 pension and financial disclosure requirements applicable to the position added to the  
6 exempt service; providing for the applicability of this Ordinance; and generally relating  
7 to personnel.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: §§ 6-2-101(a); and 6-2-103(a)  
10 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

11  
12 BY renumbering: § 7-6-101(a)(54) through (98) to be § 7-6-101(a)(55) through (99),  
13 respectively  
14 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

15  
16 BY adding: § 7-6-101(a)(54)  
17 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

19 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
20 *That § 7-6-101(a)(54) through (98) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)*  
21 *are hereby renumbered to be § 7-6-101(a)(55) through (99), respectively.*

23 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That Sections of the Anne Arundel County  
24 Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:




1 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall

5 from the date it becomes law.


