A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Exempt Service – Assistant Chief of Police and  
2 Deputy Police Chief

3  
4 FOR the purpose of changing the name of a position in the exempt service; adding a certain  
5 position to the exempt service; providing for the pay, pension, and financial disclosure  
6 requirements applicable to the position added to the exempt service; providing for the  
7 transition of a position with an incumbent employee in the classified service; providing  
8 for the applicability of this Ordinance; and generally relating to personnel.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: §§ 5-3-103(a)(2); 5-5-102; 6-2-101(a); 6-2-  
11 103(a)(18); and 7-6-101(a)(20) and (21)  
12 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

14 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
15 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 5. PENSIONS**

19 **TITLE 3. EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN**

1 **5-3-103. Participants.**

2  
3 (a) **Generally.** The participants in the plan are the following permanent full-time and  
4 permanent part-time employees who work at least 50% of the amount of time specified for  
5 the position:

6  
7 (2) appointed officials and elected officials, except for:

8  
9 (i) a Chief of Police, [an Assistant Chief of Police] A DEPUTY POLICE CHIEF,  
10 EXEMPT SERVICE, or a Police Major who elects to be a participant in the Police Service  
11 Retirement Plan;

12  
13 (ii) a Fire Chief who elects to be a participant in the Fire Service Retirement Plan;  
14 and

16 (iii) a Superintendent of Detention Facilities who elects to be a participant in the  
17 Detention Officers' and Deputy Sheriffs' Retirement Plan;

19 **TITLE 5. POLICE SERVICE RETIREMENT PLAN**

21 **5-5-102. Participants.**

22  
23 The participants in the plan are the following paid employees of the County listed in  
24 subsections (1) and (2) who are making contributions to the plan and are designated as either  
25 category I or II participants as follows:

27 (1) Category I participants include:

29 (i) Police Officer;

31 (ii) Police Officer First Class; and

33 (iii) Police Corporal; and

35 (2) Category II participants include:

37 (i) Police Sergeant;

45 (v) Deputy Police Chief IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; and

2 POLICE CHIEF, EXEMPT SERVICE, and a Police Major.

6 **TITLE 2. EXEMPT SERVICE**

8 **6-2-101. Exempt pay and benefit plan.**

9  
10 (a) **Pay grades.** The following officers and employees in the exempt service of the  
11 County are entitled to compensation at the indicated pay grade:

19 **6-2-103. Additional exempt positions.**

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21 (a) **Additional positions by title.** In addition to the positions established in § 802 of the  
22 Charter for the exempt service, there are the following positions in the exempt service whose  
23 number and classification are approved as part of the annual budget and appropriation  
24 ordinance, that may not be changed during a fiscal year except as approved by ordinance of  
25 the County Council:

27 (18) [Assistant Chief of Police] ~~TWO~~ DEPUTY POLICE ~~CHIEFS~~ CHIEF, EXEMPT  
28 SERVICE;

30 **ARTICLE 7. PUBLIC ETHICS**

32 **TITLE 6. FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE**

34 **7-6-101. Persons required to file statements.**

35  
36 (a) **Generally.** Each of the following and each candidate for County Executive or the  
37 County Council shall file with the Ethics Commission the statements provided for in this  
38 title:

40 (20) [the Assistant Chief of Police] EACH DEPUTY POLICE CHIEF, EXEMPT SERVICE;

41  
42 (21) each Deputy POLICE Chief [of Police] IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE;

44 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That, as set forth in Bill 72-13, the classified  
45 position of Deputy Police Chief will be eliminated ~~after~~ when the current occupant of the  
46 position vacates the position.


1        ~~SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That, in accordance with § 6-2-103 of the Anne~~  
2 ~~Arundel County Code (2005, as amended), this Ordinance shall approve an increase in the~~  
3 ~~Exempt Service of one Deputy Police Chief approved in these classifications as part of the~~  
4 ~~Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.~~

5  
6        SECTION 4. 3. *And be it further enacted*, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall  
7 apply to the first pay period beginning on or after July 1, 2015.




