A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personal Property Tax Credits – Foreign Trade Zones

3 FOR the purpose of extending the termination date established by Bill No. 87-01, as
4 amended by Bill No. 38-07 and Bill No. 19-12, of a certain personal property tax
5 credit for personal property located in foreign trade zones.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: Bill No. 87-01, Section 2, Laws of Anne
8 Arundel County 2001, as amended by Bill No. 38-07, Section 1, Laws of Anne
9 Arundel County 2007, and Bill No. 19-12, Section 1, Laws of Anne Arundel County
10 2012

12 WHEREAS, Bill No. 87-01, now codified as § 4-3-101 of the Anne Arundel
13 County Code (2005, as amended), provided that the personal property tax credit
14 created by Bill No. 87-01 ended on June 30, 2007; and

16 WHEREAS, Bill No. 38-07 extended the termination of the personal property tax
17 credit until June 30, 2012; and

18
19 WHEREAS, Bill No. 19-12 extended the termination of the personal property tax
20 credit until June 30, 2017; and

22 WHEREAS, the personal property tax credit for personal property located in a
23 foreign trade zone has been beneficial for the citizens of Anne Arundel County;

1 WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested that the County Council
2 continue this personal property tax credit; now therefore



4 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
5 *Maryland,* That Bill No. 87-01, Section 2, Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2001, as
6 amended by Bill No. 38-07, Section 1, Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2007, and Bill No.
7 19-12, Section 1, Laws of Anne Arundel County 2012, be and they are hereby amended
8 to read as follows:

10 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall be
11 effective commencing with the tax year that begins on July 1, 2002 and, on
12 June 30, [2017] 2022, with no further action required by the County Council,
13 this Ordinance shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

15 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
16 from the date it becomes law.




