A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Classified Service – Detention Officers – Pay
2 Increase

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the pay of detention officers in the classified service paid
5 at a certain rate and hired before a certain date; providing for the retroactive application
6 of this Ordinance; and generally relating to compensation of certain classified
7 employees.



9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
10 That employees in the classified service in the position of Detention Officer hired on or
11 before September 24, 2018, and currently compensated at Grade D-1, Step 1 or Step 2 on
12 the “Detention Center Employees (D) Pay Schedule”, as set forth in § 6-1-202(d)(1), shall
13 receive an increase in pay by advancing to Grade D-1, Step 3 on the “Detention Center
14 Employees (D) Pay Schedule”, as set forth in § 6-1-202(d)(1).

16 SECTION. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the provisions of this Ordinance shall
17 apply retroactively to the first full pay period beginning on or after September 24, 2018.

19 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
20 from the date it becomes law.
