



The Anne Arundel County-Annapolis Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) is a non-profit volunteer organization which trains community members in emergency preparedness, provides assistance in emergencies and disasters, and supports public service activities. CERT members will be officially requested by County departments for support.

Requests for operational support are managed through the

Anne Arundel County Office of Emergency Management, with CERT responding as an affiliated volunteer organization.

CERT volunteers provide community service after completing CERT basic emergency preparedness training. Examples of community service are supporting civic and patriotic events across the County with communications, traffic control, and parade marshal functions. In emergencies trained CERT members can serve as call takers, disaster shelter volunteers, pet disaster recovery volunteers, and other duties.
