Dress Code: CONSERVATIVE ATTIRE

NO shorts, open-toe shoes (flip-flops, sandals, etc.), short skirts, tank tops, baggy or excessively tight clothing. No hats; sweat suit- type clothing, bare midriff, pants with holes in them. All clothing with inappropriate/explicit writing or drawings is prohibited.

Individuals inappropriately attired will not be allowed to participate.

Dress Code and Rules

Additional Information:

Teen Court is held on Wednesday evenings, based on the school schedule

Teen Court will be postponed and rescheduled only if school is closed or all evening activities are canceled on the regular scheduled day due to inclement weather. Please contact Teen Court Coordinator for reschedule dates.

Dress Code

Remember you are going to court; conservative attire is required for all participants.

NO:

- Open-toe shoes (flip-flops, sandals, etc.)
- Shorts
- Short skirts
- Tank tops
- Baggy or excessively tight clothing
- No hats
- Sweat-suit type athletic clothing, including sweatshirts
- Bare midriffs
- Pants with holes in them
- All clothing with inappropriate/explicit writing or drawings is prohibited.
- **Individuals inappropriately attired will not be allowed to participate.**

Rules

- No cell phones, electronic games or electronic communication devices
- No gum chewing, eating or drinking
- No bottled water
- No smoking
- No photographs
- Remember that what you see and hear in the Teen Court is confidential
- No talking while Teen Court is in session
- Address the judge as "Judge_____" or "Your Honor"
- Be on time and sign in with the Teen Court Coordinator

Failure to adhere to these rules and dress code will result in immediate removal from the courtroom.

Cell phones, and all electronic communication devices, including those used for entertainment, are prohibited in the courtroom. Any prohibited device observed and/or emitting an audible sound in the courtroom is subject to immediate confiscation and submission to the Police Department's Property Management Section.
