## Please join us for a discussion on the plans for the Susans Branch Stream Restoration

To meet the requirements of the NPDES MS4 permit, Susans Branch has been identified for restoration. This stream restoration project is located within the Heritage Harbour Community off Truman Parkway in Annapolis, MD. WPRP staff will present the goals and plans for the project.

In its existing condition, this section of Susans Branch is highly eroded making it a source of nutrient and sediment loads to the South River. The primary goals of this project are to minimize bank erosion, provide vertical and lateral stability within the stream channel, and to restore the valley wide floodplain. Ultimately, this project will provide improved water quality in the South River and the Chesapeake Bay.
