

## Outdoor Pavilions at Quiet Waters Park

Pavilions can be rented for large outdoor parties and cook-outs. These covered pavilions are equipped with grills and picnic tables. All groups over 20 people must rent a pavilion when gathering in the park. Quiet Waters Parks offers six different outdoor pavilions. For more information contact the park office at (410) 222-1777.

### *Red Maple Pavilion*

The Red Maple Pavilion has a maximum capacity of 100 people. There are 12 large picnic tables, as well as two large grills available. A small children's playground is shared nearby your pavilion with the Sassafras Pavilion. Restrooms are conveniently located at a nearby comfort station. Located behind the Pavilion is the perfect place for a game of horseshoes; however, volleyball, badminton, and softball games must be organized at a large field across the street.

There will be no restrooms at the Red Maple Pavilion from November 1 to April 1.

### *Sassafras Pavilion*

The Sassafras pavilion has a maximum capacity of 100 people. There are twelve large picnic tables, and two small picnic tables, as well as two large grills available. There is also a double-sided fireplace with grills in the center. A small children's playground is shared nearby your pavilion by the Red Maple pavilion. Restrooms are located at a comfort station nearby. It is a perfect place to set up horseshoes; however, volleyball, badminton, and softball games must be organized at a large field across the street.

There will be no restrooms at the Sassafras Pavilion from November 1 to April 1.

### *Sycamore Pavilion*

The Sycamore Pavilion has a maximum capacity of 100 people. There are twelve large picnic tables, and two small picnic tables, as well as two large grills available. There is also a double-sided fireplace with grills in the center. A small playground is nearby and a large playground is within a 2 minute walk. Organized games are not recommended nearby, but you may set up horseshoes, volleyball, and badminton in the field to the south of the large playground. The closest accessible restrooms are available at the Visitor Center, which is a 6 - 8 minute walk. There is a port-a-john located at the large children's playground.

### *White Oak Pavilion*

The White Oak Pavilion has a maximum capacity of 100 people. There are twelve large picnic tables, and two small picnic tables, as well as two large grills available. A small children's playground is nearby and a large playground is across the street. Organized games are not recommended nearby, but you may set up horseshoes, volleyball, and badminton in the field to the south of the large playground. The closest accessible restrooms are available at the Visitor Center, which is a 3 - 4 minute walk. There is a port-a-john located across the street at the large children's playground.

### **Dogwood Pavilion**

The Dogwood pavilion has a maximum capacity of 50 people. There are two large picnic tables and six small picnic tables, as well as one large grill available. The closest accessible restrooms are available at the Visitor Center, which is a 2 - 3 minute walk. Boat rentals are 6-minutes away, down the adjacent Harness Creek foot path.

### **Holly Pavilion**

The Holly Pavilion has a maximum capacity of 50 people. There are two large picnic table, and six small picnic tables, as well as one large grill available. It is a perfect place to set up horseshoes, volleyball, badminton, and softball games. The closest accessible restrooms are available at the Visitor Center, which is a 3-5 minute walk.

## **PAVILION RENTAL FEES**

### **Large Pavilions (Red Maple, Sassafras, Sycamore and White Oak)**

Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Holidays (9:00 a.m.–dusk) - \$180.00 per day

Monday, Wednesday and Thursday (9:00 a.m.–dusk) - \$100.00 per day

Limit 100 people; All park entry fees apply to pavilion guests unless “prepaid parking” is purchased.

Prepaid parking – covers vehicle entry fees for pavilion guests – additional \$160.00 per day

### **Small Pavilions (Dogwood and Holly)**

Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Holidays (9:00 a.m.–dusk) - \$100.00 per day

Monday, Wednesday and Thursday (9:00 a.m.–dusk) - \$60.00 per day

Limit 50 people; All park entry fees apply to pavilion guests unless “prepaid parking” is purchased.

Prepaid parking – covers vehicle entry fees for small pavilion guests – additional \$80.00 per day

## PARK PAVILION RULES

1. Alcoholic beverages (of any kind) are not permitted in the park. Any violation of this policy will result in the group's expulsion from the park.
2. Pets must be kept on leashes and controlled at all times.
3. Vehicle entry fees are not included (unless noted). Prepaid entrance fee packages are available.
4. All park regulations must be obeyed. Client must inform their caterer (if any) of all park and contract regulations.
5. All vehicles must park in designated parking areas. Do not drive or park on the grass.
6. Use of the park for commercial profit-making functions is not permitted.
7. Amplified sound equipment, generators and moon bounces are prohibited. Electricity is not available at the pavilions.
8. Tents and canopies are not permitted.
9. Nails, thumbtacks, staples, etc. may not be used. Masking and clear tape are allowed.
10. Balloons and confetti are prohibited.
11. All decorations must be removed at the end of the event.
12. The pavilion and surrounding area must be left clean and must be cleared by posted closing time.
13. If the event is a crab feast, all trash must be removed by the client for off-site disposal.
14. Additional activities not specified in this contract must be approved in advance by the Park Superintendent.
15. Group must leave pavilion ½ hour before dusk.
