Deer Management in the Parks Informational Session

White-tailed Deer population density in our parklands far exceeds the carrying capacity of available habitat and their foraging activity is detrimental to overall forest health and regeneration. In 2009 the Anne Arundel County Department of Recreation and Parks, in coordination with the State of Maryland's Department of Natural Resources (DNR), began managing deer populations in targeted County-owned parklands using data collected from deer population surveys, staff/volunteer observations and local resident input. Each year DNR reviews and approves the management plans submitted by the Department. These plans include the selected parklands, population reduction tools to be used and the numbers of deer to be removed. DNR has approved both managed hunting and sharpshooting to reduce the deer populations in these parklands.
