<i>Who is eligible?</i>	High school age girls who do not play for a high school lacrosse team (Varsity, JV or Fresh/Soph) during the Spring of 2020	
<i>How do I sign up?</i>	<p>Registration is on-line. Go to http://www.aacounty.org/departments/recreation-parks/sports/lacrosse-girls-senior-league and click on the link "Register on Line" cost is \$100 per player plus officials fees. Payment instructions will be displayed as soon as you register on-line.</p> <p>Please register and pay as soon as possible. You are not officially registered until we receive payment. <i>Should I register even if I am trying out for my high school team?</i>	Yes. Please register as soon as possible. If you make your local high school team a refund will be processed. We need to determine the practice locations as well as # of uniforms to order.	
<i>When will the season start? How many games will be played? Practices?</i>	Games will start end of March – early April and run through Memorial Day. We have 10 games all held midweek. Games have been scheduled to be played with area High School Fresh/Soph and JV teams. The team practices once or twice a week. Practice schedules are determined by the team's coach. Practices should start around the beginning of March.	
<i>Do I have to live in Anne Arundel County?</i>	No. You can live outside the county.
