

## South County Call N' Ride

The South County Call N' Ride service is a **NEW, ON-DEMAND** transit service, that will provide three(3) zones to connect south county residents to south county service areas.

This on-demand service will operate **Monday through Friday** between the hours of **7 a.m.—7 p.m.** , excluding holidays.

Riders must call **2-hours** in advance to utilize services. Request for a 7 a.m. pick-up it can be scheduled the previous business day until 5 p.m.

**Last call for same day pick up is 5:30 p.m.**

Call N'Ride will connect to AA-Gold Edgewater route, Call N' Ride services **will not** cross over into Annapolis.

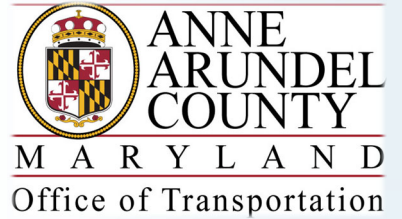
### Frequently asked Questions & Answers

**A: Yes, student I.D or Medicare card can be used as credentials.**

**A: No, service on Saturday or Sunday.**

- 1. Call (410) 222 - 0025 at least two (2) hours in advance for your desired trip. For pick-ups before 9 a.m., call between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. the previous business day to schedule.**
- 2. Schedule your pick up time by providing scheduler with exact pickup address and desired time. If no one answers, please leave your name, address and phone number. The scheduler will return your call with your scheduled pick-up time and location.**
- 3. Passengers can schedule your return trip at the same time, or you may call back 2 hours before your desired return trip.**
- 4. Pick up times are estimated and may change due to unexpected traffic delays.**
