On July 27, 2005, at approximately 2:57 p.m., the Anne Arundel County Police Department recovered human remains in the wooded area off Cross Street near Wasena Avenue, Baltimore, MD. The remains were described as a **white female, 19-23 years old, 5-05 to 5-08, dark reddish or brown curly hair**. To this day the female remains unidentified.

The Anne Arundel County Police Department sought the services of Parabon-Nano Labs, a DNA technology company that specializes in DNA phenotyping, the process of predicting physical appearance and ancestry from unidentified DNA evidence. A DNA sample from the victim in the investigation was submitted to Parabon, from which the company produced the above composite depicting her likely appearance.
