I, _____, hereby certify that I have reviewed and inspected the slab for the above referenced Building Permit # at the associated property to the applicable Building Codes as adopted under Article 15 of the Anne Arundel County Code and performed the following list of requirements:

- Verification of interior footings are located as per approved plans, size, thickness and location.
- Verification that interior draitile has been installed along the perimeter of the foundation with 4 inches minimum base of gravel below the invert of the pipe, have a total of 8 inches of gravel coverage and is connected into the sump pit. Gravel shall be clean and contain no fines.
- Verification of sump pit size and location.
- Verification that areaway drain lines run directly to sump pit.
- Verification of slab reinforcement if required.
- Verification of vapor barrier thickness and installation with the seams overlapped by 6 inches.
- All required perimeter slab insulation (thickness, width and R-value) is reviewed and attached.
- Slab thickness is reviewed and attached.
