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- (c) Employees not eligible. The following employees are not eligible to be participants in the plan:
- (1) employees hired on a part-time basis with scheduled hours less than 50% of the amount of time specified for the position;
 - (2) [an employee] EMPLOYEES hired on a temporary basis; and
- (3) [an employee] EMPLOYEES hired under the provisions of [§ 6-2-106 of this Code and either] § 802(a)(14) or § 802(a)(17) of the Charter OR § 6-2-103(B) OF THIS CODE.

ARTICLE 6. PERSONNEL

TITLE 2. EXEMPT SERVICE

6-2-103. Additional exempt positions.

- (A) Additional positions by title. [In addition to the positions established in § 802 of the Charter for the exempt service, there are the following positions in the exempt service whose number and classification are approved as part of the annual budget and appropriation ordinance, that] IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 802(B) OF THE CHARTER THE POSITIONS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION ARE ESTABLISHED AS POSITIONS IN THE EXEMPT SERVICE THAT ARE IN ADDITION TO THE POSITIONS ESTABLISHED BY § 802(A) OF THE CHARTER, WITH THE COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITIONS SET FORTH IN THE EXEMPT PAY AND BENEFIT PLAN. UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY THIS SUBSECTION THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS UNDER EACH TITLE DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE APPROVED AS PART OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AND may not be changed during a fiscal year except as approved by ordinance of the County Council. THE POSITIONS ARE:
- (B) Additional positions by nature of funding source. POSITIONS NOT IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE THAT ARE ASSIGNED TO THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND FUNDED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY STATE OR FEDERAL FUNDS OTHER THAN GRANT FUNDS ARE ESTABLISHED AS ADDITIONAL POSITIONS IN THE EXEMPT SERVICE. THE COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITIONS SHALL BE SET FORTH IN WRITTEN AGREEMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MISCELLANEOUS EXEMPT EMPLOYEES PAY AND BENEFIT PLAN. THIS PROVISION DOES NOT PRECLUDE THE COUNTY FROM ALSO ASSIGNING POSITIONS IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE COUNTY TO THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES.

6-2-106. Miscellaneous exempt employees pay and benefit plan.

An [exempt] employee in an hourly rate position or in a State or federal grant-funded position THAT IS IN THE EXEMPT SERVICE PURSUANT TO § 802(B)(14) OR (17) OF THE CHARTER OR IN A POSITION ASSIGNED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES THAT IS IN THE EXEMPT SERVICE PURSUANT TO § 6-2-103(B) OF THIS CODE shall receive pay and benefits as specified in a written agreement between the employee and the [appointing authority] COUNTY and in accordance with available appropriations in the annual budget and appropriation ordinance.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
