the real property on which it is imposed. The stormwater remediation fee shall be collected as 1 provided in § 1-9-101 of this Code. THE CONTROLLER SHALL INCLUDE AN EXPLANATION ON 2 IN EACH PROPERTY TAX BILL THAT INDICATES THAT THE STORMWATER REMEDIATION FEE 3 4 INCLUDED ON THE PROPERTY TAX BILL IS A TAX REQUIRED BY MARYLAND HOUSE BILL 987, 5 ENROLLED AS CHAPTER 151 OF THE ACTS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, 2012, WHICH WAS PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND SIGNED INTO LAW BY THE GOVERNOR ON MAY 2, 6 7 2012, AND IS NOW CODIFIED AS SECTION 4-201.1(E) OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE OF THE 8 STATE CODE.
