4	FOR the purpose of creating and funding a new capital project known as the Venic		
5	Beach Shore Erosion Control District ("SECD").		
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7	BY amending: Capital Budget

11	WHEREAS, Section 716 of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon		
12	written request of the County Executive and by the affirmative vote of five		
13	members of the County Council, to amend the capital budget and to increase the		
14	total amount of appropriations to the capital budget from revenues received but		
15	not anticipated in the budget; and		
16 17	WHEDEAG		
18	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Charter, the County Executive		
19	and the Planning Advisory Board have recommended amendments to the Capital		
20	Budget by the creation of the Venice Beach SECD capital project; and		
21	WHEREAS Section 712 of the Chartest at the Cha		
22	WHEREAS, Section 712 of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon		
23	recommendation of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget; and		
24	nom revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget; and		
25	WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available		

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for appropriation; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the Capital Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, is hereby amended by:

(1) creating a new capital project, Venice Beach SECD, Capital Project No. Q573800; and

(2) making a supplemental appropriation of loaned funds received from and fees for services provided by the Maryland Department of Natural Resources in the amount of \$228,640 to the capital project, Venice Beach SECD, Capital Project No. Q573800.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Capital Program is hereby amended to add the new capital project Venice Beach SECD, Capital Project No. Q573800, with the following description: "This project is authorized for the design and construction of a living shoreline shore erosion control project by the Venice Beach Citizens Association, Inc. for the Venice Beach SECD. The project is partially funded by a 20 year interest-free loan from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources to the County. The project is subject to the review and approval of the Maryland Department of Natural Resources. The loan will be repaid through an annual special tax assessment for the properties within the Venice Beach SECD. The project also includes services provided by the Maryland Department of Natural Resources relative to the project."

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That the Capital Program and the Capital Projects Bond Ordinance are hereby amended in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect from the date is becomes law.
