14 15 16 17	WHEREAS, Chapter 129 of the Laws of Maryland, passed by the General Assembly in 2015 and signed by the Governor on May 12, 2015, establishes a Commission Regarding the Implementation and Use of Body Cameras by Law Enforcement; and
18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, Chapter 129 also provides for the creation of guidelines for the issuance and use of body-worn cameras by the Maryland Police Training Commission on or before January 1, 2016; and
22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, the County Council supports this important effort and looks forward to receiving recommendations and guidelines for the use of body-worn cameras; and
26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, the County Council urges the support and cooperation of the Anne Arundel County Police Department and the Anne Arundel County Sheriff's Department in furtherance of this effort; now, therefore, be it
