facilities and not for replacement, maintenance, or operations. Expansion of the capacity of a road includes extensions, widening, intersection improvements, upgrading signalization, improving pavement conditions, and all other road and intersection capacity enhancement. Expansion of the capacity of a public school includes all construction and remodeling to the extent that the construction increases the capacity of the public schools. Expansion of the capacity of public safety facilities includes the construction of new or expanded police stations, fire stations, and headquarters buildings, expansion and upgrading of communications equipment, and new additions to the inventories of police patrol vehicles, fire fighting vehicles, and paramedic emergency vehicles.

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(G) **Impact fee analysis.** FUNDS COLLECTED FROM DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES AND DEPOSITED INTO ANY OF THE SPECIAL FUNDS DESCRIBED IN § 17-11-208 MAY BE USED TO FUND STUDIES AND ANALYSES REQUIRED TO DETERMINE THE APPROPRIATE AMOUNT OF DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES.

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SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
