Additional exempt positions. 2 3 In addition to the positions established in § 802 of the Charter for the exempt service, there are the following positions in the exempt service whose number and classification are 4 approved as part of the annual budget and appropriation ordinance, that may not be changed 5 during a fiscal year except as approved by ordinance of the County Council: 6 7 8 9 (20) Police Chief of Staff (civilian)[.]; 10 11 (21) ASSISTANT FIRE CHIEF; AND 12 (22) FIRE CHIEF OF STAFF (CIVILIAN). 13 14 ARTICLE 7. And be it further enacted, That, upon the recommendation of the County Executive, the exempt positions of Assistant Fire Chief and Fire Chief of Staff replace two 31 32 classified positions of Fire Division Chief that are vacant, thereby reducing the number of authorized positions of Fire Division Chief from 11 positions to 9 positions. 33 34 SECTION 4. And be it further enacted, That, upon the recommendation of the County 35 Executive, in accordance with § 6-2-103 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as 36 amended) this Ordinance shall approve an increase in the Exempt Service of an Assistant Fire 37 38 Chief and a Fire Chief of Staff approved in these classifications as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance. 39 40 SECTION 5. And be it further enacted. That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from 41 the date it becomes law. 42
