## A BILL ENTITLED

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget - Board of 1 Education - Additional Appropriation and Transfers of Funds 2 3 FOR the purpose of making additional appropriations from unanticipated revenues to the 4 School Current Expense Fund for the current fiscal year; making this Ordinance an 5 emergency measure; and generally relating to additional appropriations to the current 6 expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013. 7 8 9 BY amending: Current Expense Budget 10 11 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the County Executive, the County Council may make additional appropriations from 12 revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates, 13 provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such funds are 14 15 available for appropriation; and 16 WHEREAS, § 5-105(a) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of 17 Maryland, requires that all revenues received by the Board of Education be spent 18 in accordance with the major categories of its annual budget as provided under 19 §5-101 of the Education Article, and § 5-105(c) of the Education Article requires 20 that expenditure of nonlocal funds received by the Board of Education after 21 adoption of the annual budget be approved by the County Council; and 22

**EXPLANATION:** 

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended additional appropriations of funds, and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, be and it is hereby amended by making supplemental appropriations of revenues received from anticipated sources in excess of budget estimates in the School Current Expense Fund as follows:

Federal Grants	\$ 6,423,400
State Grants	\$ 322,000

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, is hereby amended by making supplemental appropriations of such funds as enumerated in Section 1 of this Ordinance to the below-listed accounts in the School Current Expense Fund in the respective amounts set forth:

20	(2) Mid-Level Administration	\$ 250,000
21	(3) Instructional Salaries and Wages	\$ 193,000
22	(4) Other Instructional Costs	\$ 793,500

 SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and property and, being passed by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
