10	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
11	That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

(a) Guides. The following documents shall be used as a guide in the future development

of land in and the location of public services and facilities by the County:

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Anne Arundel County Master Plan for Water Supply & Sewerage Systems, 2013 ("the Plan") is hereby amended as follows:

1. On the Acknowledgements page of the Plan, under "County Executive" strike "John R. Hammond, Acting" and substitute "Laura Neuman"; under "Anne Arundel County Council" strike "Derek Fink" and substitute "Jerry Walker", strike "Jerry Walker" and substitute "John J. Grasso", and after "Dick Ladd" insert "Derek Fink"; and under "Planning Advisory Board" strike "Paul L. Higgins, Jr.", strike "Ralph Luther" and substitute "Paul L. Higgins, Jr.", and strike "Joel Wexler" and substitute "Jerry Pesterfield".

2. On page 1-5 of the Plan, at the end of the first paragraph, following "industrial property.", insert "Additional State legislation adopted in 2012 requires that as of January 1, 2013, all new on-site sewage disposal systems installed must utilize Best Available Technology (BAT) for removal of nitrogen.".

3. On page 1-7 of the Plan, at the end of Paragraph E, insert "In addition, these systems must be managed by a MDE approved controlling authority.".

4. On page 1-9 of the Plan, after Paragraph Y and before Section 1.2, add a paragraph: "Z. When State funding is requested for any extension of public water or sewer systems outside of the County's certified Priority Funding Area (PFA), the County must submit a request for a PFA Exception or a Determination of Extraordinary Circumstance to the State Smart Growth Coordinating Committee and/or the State Board of Public Works, in accordance with State requirements.".

5. On page 1-13 of the Plan, in Paragraph G, in the first line, after "used" insert "as permitted by State law"; and in Paragraph G, after "connection of" in the first and second lines, insert "existing".

6. On page 1-19 of the Plan, in the paragraph beginning with "Step 2.", in the first sentence, strike "approved" and substitute "provided an advisory recommendation".

7. On page 1-23 of the Plan, after the paragraph beginning with "Community Water Supply System", add a new paragraph: "Controlling Authority — A unit of government, a body public and corporate, or an intercounty agency authorized by the State, County, or a municipal corporation to provide for the management, operation, and maintenance of a community sewerage system, shared facility, or multi-use system.".

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8. On page 2-17 of the Plan, in the second paragraph, in the sentence beginning with "Estimates for the period 2000-2010", strike "14% births, 40% deaths and 74% net migration" and substitute "69 percent net natural increase (births minus deaths) and 31 percent net migration,"; in the same paragraph, in the last sentence, strike "48,919" and "9.8", respectively, and substitute "48,819" and "9.1", respectively.

9. On page 3-9 of the Plan, strike Table 3-3 in its entirety and substitute the following:

Change from Planned 7 8 Service to No Public Service within the Maryland City SSA for property that is preserved as part of the Oxbow Natural Area (Grid B10); Also Map S-4 (Grids B10, B11)", and on pages 9 G-1 through G-4, renumber paragraphs B.4. through B.28. to be B.5. through B. 29., 10 respectively. 11 12 12. On pages G-1 through G-5 of the Plan, in paragraphs 6, 16, 22, 24, and 25, 13 respectively, strike "P18", "P25", the first "P21", "P27", "P29" and "P30", respectively, and 14 substitute "P17, P21", "P24", "P20", "P26", "P28 and P29", respectively; on page G-2, in 15 paragraph 8 strike "parkland" and substitute "conservation land", and strike "Grid H14" and 16 substitute "Grids I13, I14, J14"; on page G-4 in paragraph 3 strike "Cox Creek SSA" and 17 substitute "Glen Burnie Low WPZ", and in paragraph 5 strike "Grid E4" and substitute "D12, 18 E12"; and on page G-5 of the Plan, in paragraph 7, at the end of the second sentence, insert 19 20 "(Grid I11)". 21 22 13. On Map W-6, change the boundary of the Crofton WPZ as shown on the attached Exhibit D, and include the indicated properties, Tax map 43, parcel 116 and part of parcels 62 and 30, in the No Public Service timing category; and edit Figure 3-1 in the Plan accordingly.

And be it further enacted, That the "Anne Arundel County Master Plan 26 for Water Supply & Sewerage Systems, 2013", prepared by the Office of Planning and 27 Zoning, which includes the Master Plan Document and Official 2000 Scale Maps (Sheets W1 28 - W12 and S1 - S12 at the scale of 1 inch equals 2000 feet), as amended collectively, "the 29 Plan", is hereby adopted. 30 31 SECTION 3. 4. And be it further enacted. That a certified copy of the Plan as amended 32 and adopted by this Ordinance shall be permanently kept on file with the Administrative 33 Officer to the County Council and the Office of Planning and Zoning. 34 35 SECTION 4. 5. 


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


Sewer Map S-7



Amendment Area





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
Water Map W-4








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Sewer Map S-5 & S-7 AMENDMENT NO. 5 Exhibit No. F





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Sewer Map S-7 Amendment No. 6





