18-2-101. Scope; applicability.

(b) **Applicability to pending and future proceedings.** Subject to the grandfathering provisions of COMAR Title 27, this article applies to all pending and future proceedings and actions of any board, department, or agency empowered to decide applications under this Code, except that:

(4) AN APPLICATION FOR A VARIANCE TO THE CONDITIONAL USE REQUIREMENTS OF § 18-10-131(A) TO ALLOW LICENSED PREMISES OF A LICENSED DISPENSARY OF MEDICAL CANNABIS AS A PRINCIPAL USE, AS DEFINED IN COMAR 10.62.01.01, IN A W2 INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT THAT IS FILED BEFORE JUNE 4, 2018 SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE LAW AS IT EXISTED PRIOR TO JUNE 4, 2018.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
