10	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
11	That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

19	(c) Dangerous animal licenses. This subsection applies to any County resident, dog
20	fancier, cat fancier, or commercial kennel owner owning a dangerous or potentially
21	dangerous animal.

23	(3) The special license fee for a dangerous animal is [\$250.00] \$125.00 annually.
24	The fee for an animal found to be potentially dangerous prior to October 1, 2017 is \$100
25	annually.
