12 13 14 15	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That § 9-1-603 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) be and is hereby repealed.

12-6-105. Electronic Control Devices.

- (A) **Definition.** IN THIS SECTION, "ELECTRONIC CONTROL DEVICE" HAS THE MEANING UNDER SECTION 4-109 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.
- (B) **Permitted.** A PERSON WHO MEETS THE STATE REQUIREMENTS FOR POSSESSION OF AN ELECTRONIC CONTROL DEVICE MAY POSSESS AN ELECTRONIC CONTROL DEVICE.
- (C) **Violation.** A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE UP TO \$500 AND IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 30 DAYS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PENALITES SET FORTH IN § 9-1-101 OF THIS CODE.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
