19	(d) Notice. At least 21 days before the date of [the] A community meeting, the
20	developer shall mail by first class mail a notice of the date, time, and location of the meeting
21	to all lot owners within [175] 300 feet of the property [to be subdivided] SUBJECT TO THE
22	APPLICATION; to the president of any community or homeowners' association of any
23	subdivision that is located within [175] 300 feet of the property [to be subdivided] SUBJECT

TO THE APPLICATION that is on the list of community associations, persons, and organizations maintained in the Office of the County Executive; to the Office of Planning and Zoning; and to the Councilmember of the Councilmanic District in which the [subdivision] PROPERTY SUBJECT TO THE APPLICATION is located and, if the property abuts another Councilmanic district, to that County Councilmember.
