12	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,
13	Maryland, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) (and as
14	amended by Bill Nos. 75-16, 83-16, and 96-16) read as follows:

16	ARTICLE 18. ZONING

18	TITLE 10. REQUIREMENTS FOR CONDITIONAL USES
19	
20	18-10-127. Licensed premises of licensed dispensaries, growers and processors of
21	medical cannabis.

(a) **Dispensary.** Licensed premises of a licensed dispensary of medical cannabis as a principal use, as defined in COMAR 10.62.01.01, shall comply with all of the following requirements.

(1) Premises LOCATED north of [Maryland] <u>U.S.</u> Route 50 [and east] OR PREMISES LOCATED NORTH OF THE NORTHEAST SHORE of the South River may not be located within 1,000 feet of a dwelling or residentially zoned property, or the lot line of a public

or private school or real property owned by the Board of Education.

TITLE 11. REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIAL EXCEPTION USES

18-11-132. Licensed premises of licensed dispensaries of medical cannabis.

Licensed premises of a licensed dispensary of medical cannabis, as defined in COMAR 10.62.01.01, shall comply with all of the following requirements.

(1) Premises LOCATED north of [Maryland] <u>U.S.</u> Route 50 [and east] OR PREMISES LOCATED NORTH OF THE NORTHEAST SHORE of the South River may not be located within 1,000 feet of a dwelling or residentially zoned property, the lot line of a public or private school, or the lot line of real property owned by the Board of Education.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
