SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland
That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

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1 ANNE ARUNDEL COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM FEES FOR 2 PRELIMINARY PLANS, SITE DEVELOPMENT PLANS, AND MODIFICATIONS. 3 4 17-11-203. Who must pay fees. 5 6 (c) Exemptions. 7 (1) Subject to the conditions set forth in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, 8 the following shall be exempt from impact fees: 9 10 (i) facilities for assisted living programs, as defined in the Health-General 11 Article, § 19-1801, of the State Code; 12 13 14 (ii) hospice facilities, as defined in the Health-General Article, § 19-901(c), of 15 the State Code; 16 (iii) hospitals, as defined in the Health-General Article, § 19-301(f), of the State 17 Code: 18 19 20 (iv) nursing homes, as defined in the Health-General Article, § 19-1401(e), of 21 the State Code: 22 (v) residential dwelling units, provided that the sale or rental of the units is 23 restricted to persons having a household income not exceeding 120 percent of the area 24 median income, adjusted by household size, as defined by the United States Department of 25 Housing and Urban Development, or that the units were constructed under a program that 26 requires the homebuyers to participate in the initial construction or rehabilitation of the 27 units; [and] 28 29 30 (vi) a fire station on property owned by a volunteer fire company formed pursuant to § 12-1-201 of this Code[.]; AND 31 32 33 (VII) FACILITIES FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COMMUNITY COLLEGE ON PROPERTY 34 OWNED BY OR LEASED TO ANNE ARUNDEL COMMUNITY COLLEGE. 35 (2) To be eligible for exemption under paragraph (1)(I) THROUGH (VI): 36 37 38 (i) a facility for an assisted living program, hospice facility, hospital, nursing home, or a fire station on property owned by a volunteer fire company formed pursuant to § 12-1-201 of this Code shall be owned and operated by an entity exempt from taxation under § 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code that has been in existence for at least three years preceding the date of application for the exemption under paragraph (3); or (ii) a residential dwelling unit was constructed by or under a program sponsored by an entity exempt from taxation under § 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code that has been in existence for at least three years preceding the date of application for the exemption under paragraph (3).

1 (3) A person seeking exemption under this subsection shall, upon submission of an initial application for subdivision or submission of a site development plan for review, 2 complete an application for exemption supplied by the Office of Planning and Zoning and 3 provide any additional information the Planning and Zoning Officer believes to be 4 necessary to determine eligibility for the exemption. The Office of Planning and Zoning 5 shall notify the person of a determination of eligibility in the letter approving a sketch plan 6 for a subdivision, a final plan for a minor subdivision, or recommending approval of a 7 building or grading permit for a site development plan. 8 9 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Anne Arundel County Construction 10 and Property Maintenance Codes Supplement, October 1, 2005 (as amended) read as 11 follows: 12 13 14 CONSTRUCTION AND PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODES 15 **SUPPLEMENT October 1, 2005** 16 17 **CONSTRUCTION CODE** 18 19 Chapter 1 20 **Construction Code Administrative Provisions** 21 22 Section 108 23 **Fees** 24 108.2.1.2 Government agencies and Anne Arundel Community College. A 25 government agency will be issued permits without charge if construction inspection 26 and enforcement is provided by a government agency other than the County. All 27 permits will be issued to Anne Arundel County and Anne Arundel Community 28 29 COLLEGE without charge. 30 SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days 31 32 from the date it becomes law. READ AND PASSED this 15th day of October, 2018
