FISCAL NOTE

BILL: AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE CONCERNING: CURRENT EXPENSE BUDGET – BOARD OF EDUCATION -- SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION AND TRANSFER OF FUNDS

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

This bill appropriates \$23,005,300 of additional funds to the Board of Education (BOE) and transfers funds among major categories of expenditure in the Local Education Fund.

FISCAL IMPACT

Section 1 of the bill recognizes \$11,284,100 of combined State and Federal grants, and local revenues a including \$5,000,000 of additional fund balance. Section 2 of the bill decreases appropriations by a total of \$11,721,200. Funds from the grants, local revenues, fund balance and decreased appropriations are the sources to provide increased appropriations of \$23,005,300 reflected in Section 3 of the bill. The table below shows that sources and appropriation decreases and increases:
