## **FISCAL NOTE**

BILL: AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Third Quarter Fund Transfer and Supplementary Appropriations

## **SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION**

This ordinance provides for the transfer of appropriation authority between County departments within the General Fund.

Section 1 of the bill transfers \$195,000 from the CAO contingency account to provide \$195,000 of appropriation authority to be transferred to the agency listed in the table below:

Section 2 of the bill recognizes \$777,300 of revenue received from sources not anticipated in the budget in Grants Special Revenue Fund to be used as follows:
