19	(A) Judge. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B), EACH JUDGE OF THE ORPHANS
20	COURT IS ENTITLED TO AN ANNUAL SALARY OF \$39,000.
21	TO ALL THE PROPERTY OF THE PRO
22	(B) Chief Judge. THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE ORPHANS' COURT IS ENTITLED TO AN
23	ANNUAL SALARY OF \$39,500.
24	That this Online and shall take affect 45 days
25	SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
26	from the date it becomes law.
