Reopening and Revised Service Operations

Customer Express Station

Customers who complete business in the Inspections and Permits office with questions for OPZ will have access to an OPZ Customer Express Station to contact the department via email or by phone. Masks will be provided for those who are unvaccinated or would prefer to wear a mask. All in-person meetings will be limited to <u>eight</u> people in OPZ offices. Logistics for safe convening of commissions, task forces, and work groups will be determined by OPZ and group chairpersons.
