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1 2 3	RESOLUTION confirming the appointment of a member of the classified service to serve on the Pension Oversight Commission for Anne Arundel County
4	WHEREAS, Section 606(a) of the Charter provides that there shall be a Pension
5	Oversight Commission that is independent of both the legislative and executive
6	branches of the County government; and

8	WHEREAS, Section 606(b)(1) of the Charter provides that the Pension Oversight
9	Commission shall consist of nine members appointed by the County Executive and
10	confirmed by resolution of the County Council; and
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12	WHEREAS, Section 606(b)(3) of the Charter provides that four of the members
13	shall be members of the classified service as defined in Section 803 of the Charter;
14	one member shall be a uniformed police officer; one member shall be a professional
15	fire fighter; one member shall be a member of a class represented by the employee
16	organization that represents the majority of classified employees other than
17	uniformed police officers and professional fire fighters; and one member shall be a
18	member of the classified service other than the police department and fire
19	department, who is in a class excluded from representation by the employee
20	organization that represents the majority of classified employees other than
21	uniformed police officers and professional fire fighters; and

23	WHEREAS, Section 606(c)(1) of the Charter provides that the term of a member
24 25	shall be four years; and
26	WHEREAS, Section 606(c)(3) of the Charter provides that a member who is
27	appointed after a term has begun shall serve only for the rest of the term and until
28	a successor is appointed and qualified; and
29	a successor is appointed and quantica, and
30	WHEREAS, Section 606(c)(4) of the Charter provides that a person may not serve
31	for more than two terms as a member of the Pension Oversight Commission; and
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33	WHEREAS, the County Executive, subject to confirmation by the County Council,
34	has appointed Lt. Erik R. Kornmeyer (professional fire fighter) to a first term
35	commencing on February 1, 2018, and expiring on January 31, 2022; and
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37	WHEREAS, the County Council, after public hearing, finds that Lt. Erik R.
38	Kornmeyer meets the eligibility requirements under Section 606(b)(3) of the

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Charter and is qualified to serve on the Pension Oversight Commission; now, therefore, be it

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Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it hereby approves the appointment to the Pension Oversight Commission of Lt. Erik R. Kornmeyer (professional fire fighter) to a first term commencing February 1, 2018, and expiring January 31, 2022; and be it further
