12	WHEREAS, the County Council, as the legislative body for Anne Arundel County,
13	and also the Board of Health for Anne Arundel County, has the authority to declare
14	public nuisances and establish regulations to combat nuisances; and

16	WHEREAS, the pervasiveness of bullying, both in schools and in the general
17	public, through social media and other technologies as well as in person threats, has
18 19	risen to a level to be a condition dangerous to human health; and
20	WHEREAS, the County Council requests that Anne Arundel County Department
21	of Health provide information at the May meeting of the Anne Arundel County
22	Board of Health regarding their bullying prevention and education efforts and steps
23	they will to take to address bullying as a public health nuisance; now, therefore, be
