RESOLUTION urging the County Executive not to use funds received by Anne
Arundel County from the federal government, pursuant to an Intergovernmental Service
Agreement, for the legal representation of County detainees in civil proceedings instituted
by the Department of Homeland Security and pledging not to approve any related
budgetary requests

WHEREAS, Anne Arundel County and the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, a component of the Department of Homeland Security, are parties to an Intergovernmental Service Agreement (the "IGSA") that allows holding up to 130 male detainees, aged 18 or older, with medium to low security ratings at the Ordnance Road Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, in the first 13 months of the program, the County received \$4,015,693 under the IGSA for housing detainees; and

WHEREAS, on December 27, 2018 County Executive Steuart Pittman committed to continuing the County's participation in the IGSA and stated that future funds received pursuant to the IGSA would be directed to the following spending categories: detention staffing, public safety, and legal representation of detainees; and

WHEREAS, the use of IGSA funds to provide legal representation to County detainees in civil, non-criminal proceedings instituted by the Department of Homeland Security provides greater benefits to these detainees than are provided to citizens of the United States; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it hereby urges the County Executive, on behalf of Anne Arundel County, to refrain from making any budget requests that any general funds, including those received pursuant to the IGSA, be used to provide legal representation to detainees housed in Anne Arundel County Detention Facilities in civil proceedings instituted by the Department of Homeland Security; and be it further

Resolved, That it hereby pledges not to approve any budget requests from the County Executive that any general funds, including those received pursuant to the IGSA, be used to provide legal representation to detainees housed in Anne Arundel County Detention Facilities in civil proceedings instituted by the Department of Homeland Security; and be it further
