<p><b>1</b> Coordinate support systems for youth based on trusted relationships</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coordinate services to meet basic needs, focusing on public and subsidized housing communities</li> <li>• Build trust with Annapolis residents</li> <li>• Improve awareness and utilization of available resources</li> <li>• Develop leadership capacity of youth to address issues in their neighborhoods</li> <li>• Promote the adoption of Evidence-Based Practices (EBPs) for prevention, intervention, enforcement/suppression, and re-entry</li> <li>• Utilize placed-based and two-generation approaches in public and subsidized housing communities</li> <li>• Develop and implement programming focused on interrupting and reducing violence</li> <li>• Increase collaboration, braid funding and resources between youth and family serving community agencies</li> <li>• Embed a trauma-informed approach in our Coordinated Systems of Care</li> <li>• Increase the capacity of community-serving agencies with a focus on leadership development, program measurement, planning, and resource development</li> <li>• Bring together leaders and concerned residents across Annapolis to raise awareness and address systemic barriers, focusing on racism and inequality</li> <li>• Create safe, vibrant public spaces for recreational use in communities with the highest rates of youth violence</li> <li>• Create a robust network of bilingual speakers</li> <li>• Develop a CRICT system for the city of Annapolis</li> <li>• Expand outreach to potential partners in the county</li> <li>• Meet Annapolis residents where they are</li> <li>• Create a universal intake to expand case management capacity</li> <li>• Reduce barriers that prevent youth from actualizing their goals</li> </ul>
