<p>1 Address the basic needs of community members</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase safe, affordable transportation options • Improve access to medical care, including mobile services, prenatal care and substance use centers • Increase behavioral health services for children and parents • Advocate for funding for food programs and access to healthy foods • Host pop up food pantries • Financial literacy • Create pathways for employment • Increase trade programing opportunities • Support small businesses
<p>2 Increase safe, positive spaces for children to learn and play</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase affordable, quality early education centers • Promote healthy school environments • Support after school/out of school opportunities for children and youth • Educate parents on the importance of early learning • Increase available parenting programs • Provide cultural competency for teachers • Advocate for a drop-in center for youth and family support center in the community • Advocate for an increase in funding for children with intellectual disabilities • Create safe playgrounds and recreational areas for children/youth
<p>3 Interrupt violence and create safe spaces</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase in facilities handling domestic violence • Create more slow streets and promote road safety • Invite community problem solving through regularly scheduled Town Halls • Develop and implement programming focused on interrupting and reducing violence
<p>4 Improve housing affordability and livability</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improve the housing code enforcement to ensure properties are well maintained • Provide pro bono attorneys to the community to assist with fair housing issues • Educate tenants on their rights • Advocate for affordable rent • Advocate for policies that prevent landlords from rent gouging • Walk the neighborhoods and visit properties to ensure compliance with rules • Create an open dialogue with residents
