










Dog Park

- Lights out prior to 10 pm






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Adaptive Ball Field

- ADA Accessible

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Community Gardens/ Meditation Area

- Garden plots with a hose bib
- Meditation Area passive park area with landscaping, walking paths, and benches for seating and solitude
- Gazebo





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Parking Lot and Future Community Center

- Parking Lot improvements
- Future Community Center
- Area for future community center will be left as an open grass field until construction on community center begins
- 61 existing parking spaces
- 66 proposed parking spaces (increase of 5 spaces)





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Park Access

- Access from 11th Avenue
- Shared with Library and School access





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Stormwater Management

- Stormwater management to be accomplished by microbioretention areas
- 7 proposed at this time





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Forest Conservation

- No existing forest on site
- Wooded area to the south of the site will be supplemented within additional native vegetation to restore forest habitat to this area
- This will provide a buffer to the adjacent homes
